<u>Consultation – Barriers to longer</u> <u>tenancies</u>... (1)

- Dramatic change in PRS since 1988
- Lack of security for vulnerable tenants unplanned or unwanted moves
- Benefit to landlord less renewals and associated fees
- It's not about regulated rents or preventing a landlord to repossess their property
- New model proposed

- Do the R&DRLA want to respond to consultation?




Rotherham's Housing Strategy

English Housing Survey – PRS (1)




The majority of private renters expect to buy their own home at some point in the future



Satisfaction


The majority of private renters are satisfied with their accommodation and their status as private renters

Electrical Safety Regulations

- New rules announced 19th July 2018 in wake of Grenfell Tower tragedy
- One of a number of safety measures brought in by Government incl.:
 - Those living in high-rise buildings understand safety improvements
 - Change of culture required to hold industry to account
 - Pilot scheme leading on building safety reform
- <u>Consultation</u> into Building Reg's fire safety guidance
- No start date as yet
