# What does Roundabout do?



**Roundabout** provides shelter, support and life skills to homeless young people aged 16-25 across South Yorkshire.

**Our Vision** is that our region is free from youth homelessness, all young people have a place to call home and have the support they need to keep it.



# What does the Private Rented Service do?



- Help young people find a home
- Offer a rent deposit guarantee and small contribution towards fees
- Provide on-going support to ensure the young person can maintain their tenancy

# Who can access the Private Rented Service?



- Young people aged 18-25 (up to 26<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- Single people, couples or families
- Young people who have an income – either from work or benefits
- Young people who are capable of living independently and managing a tenancy
- Young people who are willing to engage with Roundabout and their landlord to resolve issues

# How can I get involved?



- Update us if you have any vacancies
- Let to young people who may have a low income or be claiming benefits
- Accept our rent deposit guarantee
- Work with Roundabout to solve any problems that may arise
- Inform Roundabout of any intentions regarding giving notice or ending tenancies
